

## BC Boys Basketball Website Report

Created in 2009 to help raise the awareness, provide tools to coaches and streamline registrations for Senior Boys Basketball in the Province. It now provides archived pages with pictures and statistics for future generations to look back and see what their Fathers accomplished. Team pictures, individual player head shots and personal biographies, individual player and team stats.

Standings are updated automatically as soon as a score is entered. If every team in the province would submit there schedule in advance of the start of the season and if every team would enter the score from each of their games immediately after every game they play we would have a central website where you can find scores & standings for every league and tier in the province.

Here are answers to some questions from coaches.

1. Why do I have to submit a roster if I already submitted one to BCSS?  
Sometimes a team will put a roster in to BCSS in September but by the time the season arrives the school can't field a team. The roster is how BC Boys executive count teams for the berthing formula so the count would be off which might take away a berth from a zone with legitimate numbers. It is hoped that once a coach enters the roster it would follow that individual statistics would show up and help promote Boys Basketball.

2. Why do I have to submit a picture when we are really weak and a picture won't be needed for the BC program?  
It promotes interest in the game.

3. How can I put a score up on the site?  
First you have to send your schedule so that it can be entered and then use your passwords to put it up. Tournaments are a little harder but send the information and it gets put up.

4. Why can't I put my own schedule up on the website?  
In case you make a mistake and delete something that is important only mid-level website administrators are allowed to add or change scheduled games. In the process we do find scheduling conflicts and inform coaches so that they may be corrected before a problem occurs.

5. How can I put up my own notice on the noticeboard?  
Only mid-level website administrators are allowed in to that section.

6. Why do I have to put my exhibition games on the website?

To help promote interest in the sport of basketball. There may be fans of high school basketball who want to come to one of the scheduled games. Exhibition games

help with comparisons for the rankings.

7. Our team has it's own stats program why can't we just download our stats on to the website stats page.

Unfortunately the website is an "out of the box" website and doesn't have the capability of handling many custom functions.
